1. Cite the rule that states all Democratic Party meetings shall be open to the public, and that at Democratic Party meetings, all votes shall not be taken by secret ballot.

DNC Charter Page 8, Section 12

2. Cite the rule outlining the responsibilities of a Region Chair.

3. Cite the rule outlining the responsibilities of a District Chair.

2016 DPH Bylaws, Page 15, Section 1C(1)

4. If you are the County, District or Region Chair, cite the responsibilities of the County Chair. If you are none of these, cite the rule outlining your responsibilities.

5. Find the rule that says how many district council meetings must be held each year. What is the number?

2016 DPH Constitution, Page 3, Section 4. District Council meetings shall be held at least 3 times per year.

6. Find the rule that says how much notice must be given for a District Council meeting. What is the amount?

2016 DPH Bylaws, Page 16, Article III, Section 2, Lines 34-36. Notice shall be given not less than 5 days prior to the meeting

7. What rule states that complaints must be signed by one (1) party member, and endorsed by at least four (4) other Party members?

2016 DPH Bylaws, Page 5, Article I, Section 8b(2) Line 36

8. What rule states that OCC members only get 3 minutes to speak during the debate of a motion?

Special and Standing Rules, 10, January 2015, DPH Oahu County Democrats.

9. Can you move to adjourn the meeting right in the middle of debate?

Yes – Privileged Motion – You can't interrupt the speaker (Appendix – 13 Ranking Motions)

10. Can you interrupt the speaker to ask where the men's room is?

Yes – Request for information – You can interrupt the speaker (Appendix – Parliamentary Motions – Incidental and "Bring Back" Motions)
