Today we examine the rules governing the dates and times of our biennial precinct meetings and the Oahu County convention.

1. Cite the section in the DPH Constitution that specifies the date of our biennial precinct meetings.

What does it say?

The date is not on the SCC agenda so what would you expect the date in 2018 to be?

2. Cite the section in the DPH Bylaws that specifies when the biennial precinct meeting locations, dates and times must be published in the newspaper.

Make sure you are familiar with the roles of the county chair, precinct president and district chair in December of odd numbered years, as well as the significance of the first week of December, December 15th, December 21 in odd numbered years, and January 5 of even numbered years.

By what date must this list be published in 2018?

Who's responsible for publishing the location and time of *your* precinct meeting?

3. Cite the section in the Oahu County Bylaws that specifies *how late* in an even year the county convention can be held.

What does it say and what date would that be in 2018?

The state legislature will likely adjourn the first Friday in May. What day is that in 2018?

4. Cite the rule in the Oahu County Bylaws that specifies *when* the District Council is entitled to fill At Large delegate positions to the county convention.

When is it?

Cite the section of the rule that specifies what kind of meetings the District Council can have to fill these vacant At Large delegate positions.

Can the District Council fill At Large delegate positions at a face-to-face meeting at a place like Zippy's or Starbucks?
