Region 9 Democrats held a meeting on December 11, 2017 to discuss strategy and next steps regarding the 2018 Democratic Party conventions, Get-Out-The-Vote for the 2018 elections, and grassroots community organizing for the Democratic Party of Hawaii. There was some discussion of the proposal to split Region 9 into two regions, which will be further discussed at the next meeting on January 8, 2018.

We respectfully request an agenda item be added to the December 30, 2017 Oahu County Committee meeting agenda, to remove Glenn Ida and Charles Prentiss as authorized signatories on the Region 9 Bank Account (Account Number 36-096632 with First Hawaiian bank in Kailua) and replace with Oahu County Treasurer Raphael Leonard. First Hawaiian Bank needs a copy of the meeting minutes with this information included in order to make the change.

The District Chairs in our Region are in the process of securing the following locations for our District's Precinct Meetings to be held on March 07, 2018:

District 48: Key Project Multipurpose Community Center, 47-200 Waihe'e Road, Kāne'ohe (Location Successfully Confirmed by District 48 Chair Bill South)

District 49: Kaneohe Elementary School Cafeteria, 45-495 Kamehameha Hwy, Kāne'ohe (Location Tentatively Reserved by District 49 Chair Betty Vega)

District 50: Kailua District Park Multipurpose Room, 21 S Kainalu Dr, Kailua (Location Tentatively Reserved by District 50 Chair Lynne Sager)

District 51: Keolu Elementary School Cafeteria, 1416 Keolu Dr, Kailua (Not yet reserved, I have been unable to contact the District 51 Chair, but with the County Chair's permission, I will go ahead and reserve the school myself.)

Our next Region 9 Meeting is scheduled for January 8, 2018, where we will discuss the potential Region 9 split, the Biennial Precinct Meetings in March, the upcoming County and State Conventions, and fundraising ideas to help our delegates get to the State Convention in 2018.
