## Proposed Amendment to DPH Bylaws.

The DPH Constitution Article IX Section 2 provides that the DPH Bylaws can be amended at any regular meeting of the SCC by a majority vote of all members, provided the amendment has been submitted in writing at the previous regular meeting.

## DPH Bylaws Article IX, Page 34. Add Section 9

## 1 Section 9. Sexual Harassment Policy

- 2 The Democratic Party of Hawai'i is committed to providing an environment that is free from sexual
- 3 harassment. Sexual harassment will not be tolerated.
- 4 Any member who is a witness to, or victim of a statement or act, interpreted by the victim or witness as
- 5 sexual harassment by another member, may file a complaint against the accused member.
- 6 Members accused of sexual harassment may be subject to disciplinary action as defined in DPH Bylaws
- 7 Article I, Section 8. Disciplinary action may also require the accused member complete an SCC approved
- 8 sexual harassment awareness training course.

## 9 Definition of Sexual Harassment

- 10 All Democratic Party members of all ages and genders must be aware of what constitutes sexual
- 11 harassment. Unwelcome sexual advances, as well as verbal or physical conduct of a sexual nature
- 12 constitute sexual harassment. The intention of the statement or act that is not relevant, but the effect of
- 13 the behavior on the individual.
- 14 Unwelcome actions such as the following are inappropriate and, depending on the circumstances, may
- in and of themselves meet the definition of sexual harassment or contribute to a hostile volunteer
- 16 environment:

- Sexual teasing, jokes, or innuendo, in person or via e-mail;
- Kissing, grabbing, unwanted hugging or touching;
  - Repeatedly standing too close to or brushing up against a person;
- Repeatedly asking a person to socialize when the person has said no or has indicated they are
  not interested;
- Giving gifts or leaving objects that are sexually suggestive;
  - Making derogatory gender based comments or sexually suggestive gestures;
- Making or posting sexually demeaning or offensive pictures, cartoons or other materials;
- Unwelcome conduct of a sexual nature that affects the volunteer environment.
- A victim of sexual harassment can be any gender. The victim can be of the same gender as the harasser.
- 27 The harasser can be a party volunteer, officer, candidate or employee.
