- Any member of a District Council
- An At-Large District Delegate
- A current elected Democratic official
- A former Oʻahu County Chair



To sign up to become an At-Large District Delegate, contact your District Chair.

After you are designated as a convention delegate, pay your registration fee online or via mail:

- Early-bird rate: \$15 if paid before 11:59 p.m., April 14, 2023
- Regular rate: \$20 if paid before 11:59 p.m., April 28, 2023
- Late Rate: \$40 if paid before 11:59 p.m., May 10, 2023




