How to Cast Your Ballot



1) Complete your ballot and put it in the mail.

Remember, ballots need to be **<u>RECIEVED</u>** by August 13 at 7 p.m. so allow time for your ballot to be sent through the mail.



Complete your ballot and submit it directly to a Voter Service Center or Ballot Drop Box.

3) Go down to a Voter Service Center and vote in-person.

On your ballot, select the DEMOCRATIC PARTY.

Make sure to vote ONLY for candidates listed under the Democratic Party on your ballot for partisan races. Voting across parties will make your ballot ineligible.

You will still vote in all non-partisan races like City Council or OHA.
