To attend the convention, you need to be a convention delegate. Additionally, if you are interested in becoming a member of our pre-convention committees, you need to be a convention delegate and pay your convention fee.



You are already a delegate if you are:

- Any member of a District Council
- An At-Large District Delegate
- A current elected Democratic official
- A former Oahu County Chair



To sign up to become an At-Large District Delegate, contact your District Chair.

All convention delegates must also register and pay the registration fee before attending the convention or participating in pre-convention committees.

- Early-bird rate: \$15 if paid before 11:59 p.m., April 14, 2023
- Regular rate: \$20 if paid before 11:59 p.m., April 28, 2023
- Late Rate: \$40 if paid before 11:59 p.m., May 10, 2023
