- (If all 15 spots are filled, a district may vote to elect 2 additional Vice Chairs and 1 additional Secretary)

- Elect Delegates to DNC Convention
- Discuss and adopt changes to the DPH Platform and Bylaws
- Discuss and adopt Resolutions

Help with Pre-Convention Work

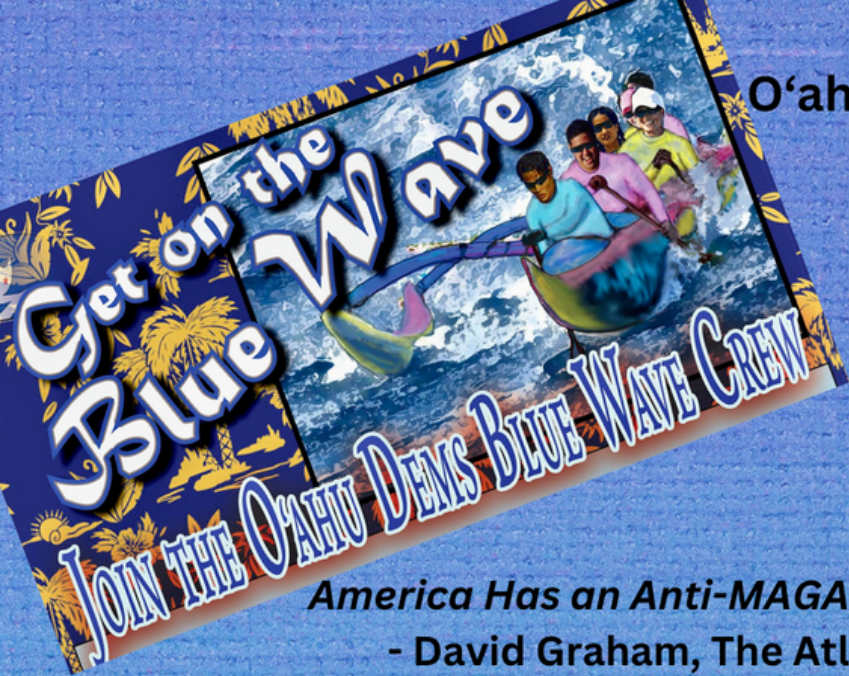

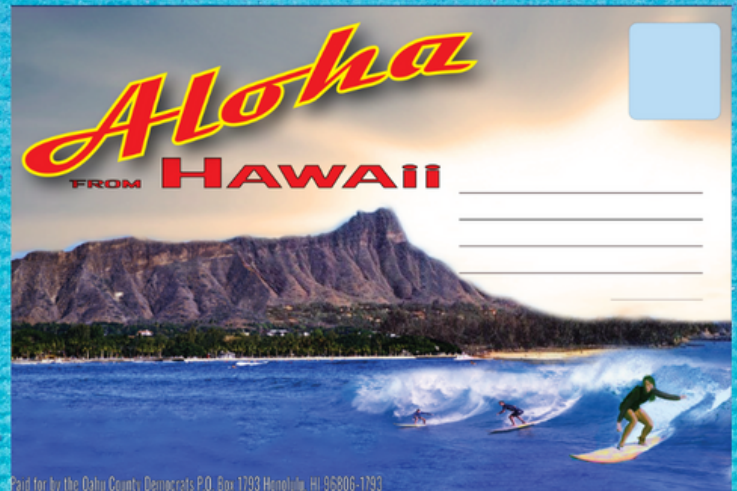
