2019 O'ahu County Democrats Election & Nomination Rules

from the Bylaws of the O'ahu County Democrats

Section 2. Executive Committee

(2.11) Election of Executive Committee. With the exception of Regional Chairpersons, each member of the Executive Committee shall be elected by a majority of the votes cast at the O'ahu County Convention in odd-numbered years. The Regional Chairpersons shall be elected at the same convention by a majority of votes cast in their respective regions.

Section 5. Eligibility.

(5.1) Any member of the Party residing in the County may be elected an officer of the County Committee including County Chairperson, with the requirement that any member seeking the office of County Chairperson shall have been a member of the Party for at least one (1) year prior to the County Committee Officers election. Elected officials, individuals appointed to fill an elected office, or candidates for elected office are not eligible to become County Chairperson. If a member has resigned from the Party in the two years prior to re-enrollment, the re-enrolled member must be a member in good standing for at least one year prior to the County Committee Officers election prior to being elected an officer of the County Committee.

If a District Chairperson, Precinct President, Precinct First Vice-President or a Precinct District Councilperson is elected as a County officer, that person shall automatically vacate the lesser office. Any person who wishes to be a candidate for Chairperson, Vice-Chairperson, Secretary, Assistant Secretary, Treasurer, Assistant Treasurer or Regional Chairperson shall file nomination papers at least ten (10) days prior to the County Convention. The <u>nomination papers shall be signed by not</u> <u>less than ten (10) members</u> of the Democratic Party of Hawai'i residing in the County or Region being represented.

Section 6. Term of Office.

Term of Office. Immediately following the adjournment of the O'ahu County Convention in odd numbered years, the OCC Executive Committee shall organize and take office immediately and shall hold office until the adjournment of the next O'ahu County Convention held in an odd numbered year, except for OCC State Central Committee Representatives who shall hold office until the next O'ahu County Convention in an even-numbered year.

from the Convention Standing Rule 9:

In 2019 elections will be held for County Chairperson, County Vice Chairperson, County Secretary, County Assistant Secretary, County Treasurer, County Assistant Treasurer, and Nine (9) Regional Chairpersons. The election shall be decided by a majority of votes cast.

Election shall be by ballot unless there is only one nominee for a position in which case election shall be by acclamation. OCC members shall not hold more than one nor be a candidate for more than one office on the Executive Committee.

In contested races, candidates may speak for two minutes each. Delegates shall elect candidates for contested positions using a single, first ballot; provided, however, delegates from each region shall have separate ballots to elect Regional Chairs where more than one candidate is running for the same position. If no candidate receives a majority on the first ballot, then a second ballot between the top two vote getters shall be conducted.

Ties shall be decided by the flip of a coin.
